NOTES

- 1. You must pay at least as much or more UK income tax and/or capital gains tax (for the year of the donation) as the amount that will be claimed by Arkwright and any other charities and CASCs (Community Amateur Sports Clubs) you donate to during each tax year. You will be responsible for any shortfall of tax.
- 2. Basic rate tax is currently 20 per cent, so this means that if you give £10 using Gift Aid, it's worth £12.50 to each charity you donate to.
- 3.
