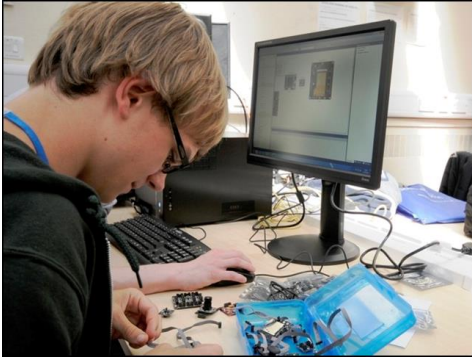


Could you help nurture a future leader in engineering?

Arkwright invites volunteers to join our well-established mentoring programme and to take this opportunity to support and guide an outstanding, engineering-minded 16/18 year old, who has a strong interest in various engineering subjects during a critical stage in their education.

'Mentoring' can take many forms and Scholars would value answers to general questions such as "What is it like to study at university?" as much as they would value detailed technical insights. Every Scholar, and every potential mentor, is different. Arkwright is flexible about the form and time that any individual mentoring relationship takes. The only mandatory requirement is that all mentors must be CRB / DBS checked (easily achieved by registering as a STEMNET Ambassador).

What are the benefits to the Scholar?
